Registering

Having accessed the Component Manager you will be taken straight to the login page. Click 'Register' and complete the online form.

Editing Components

The Eco3D Component Manager uses a unique user interface designed specifically to help users edit their components quickly and efficiently to get the most from their efforts. The purpose of this system is to allow you to update your listing / components quickly and easily as well as adding new ones. Each listing is processed to create a Component VCM file which is used by Eco3D Software Suite end users within their simulations.

Components can be viewed side by side with one as a template where details can quickly be copied to a target component.

Within the account area full user permissions allow access for different employees to be managed by selected admin users.

Component listings are fully customisable and all details will be visible through the Eco3D Component Library to its extensive user base.

Bulk importing of component data is supported, allowing users to update thousands of listing simultaneously with existing data.
